During an emergency, fire fighters may come into the building. I will listen to them like I listen to my teachers.

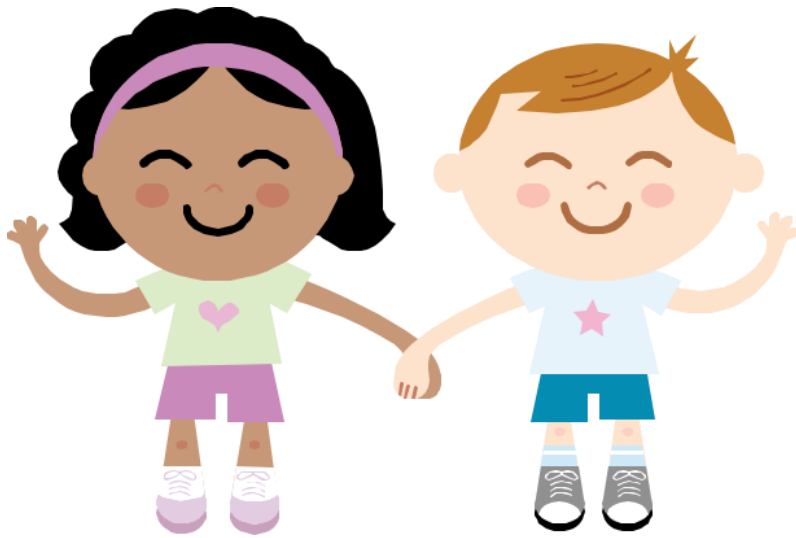


Spometimes we will practice fire drills, evacuation drills, and lockdown drills so that we are safe.
