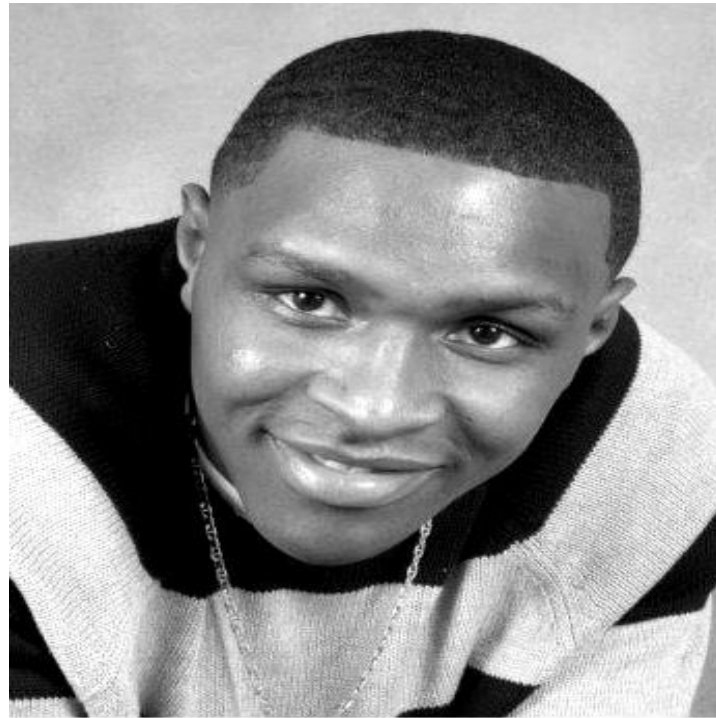


JASON CROSS
